

Overview

The 2010 ADA Standard, states in Section 225. 2 that at least 1 of 200 lockers in a facility must be accessible and that in a facility with more space than 201, 10 plus 2% of lockers must be accessible. To adhere to ADA standards, a minimum of 5% of the lockers provided must meet ADA requirements, with at least one locker meeting these standards. The code also states that if lockers are in a cluster at least 5% or 1 locker must be. 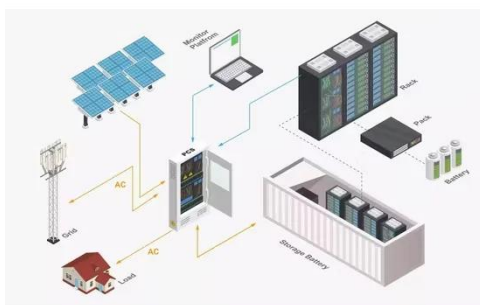

ADA Accessible Lockers

Lockers should be placed in an area that allows full door swing and wheelchair turning ability. Lockers shall be placed in a location at least 24" away from any wall or other obstacle and have a minimum ...

ADA Compliant Lockers

Clearance in front of locker must be a minimum of 24" away from the lockers and 30" in width along the lockers. Foreman's recommended clearance is

60", circular to allow for a wheel chair to turn.

It's critical to note that ADA code requires design consideration to ensure usability of special needs users. Accessible means that the space must abide the regulation in section 811 and ...
