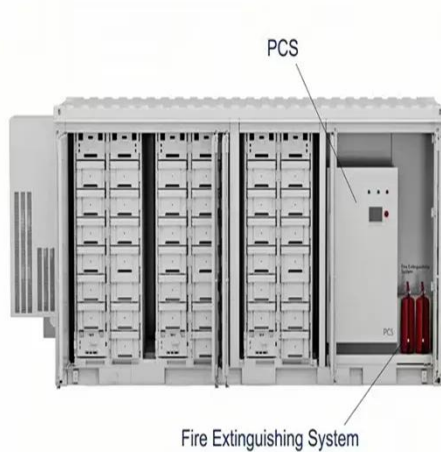
Sri Lanka electricity generation surge in May amid economic recovery
