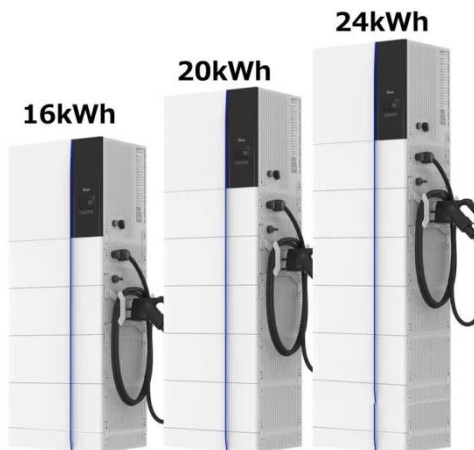

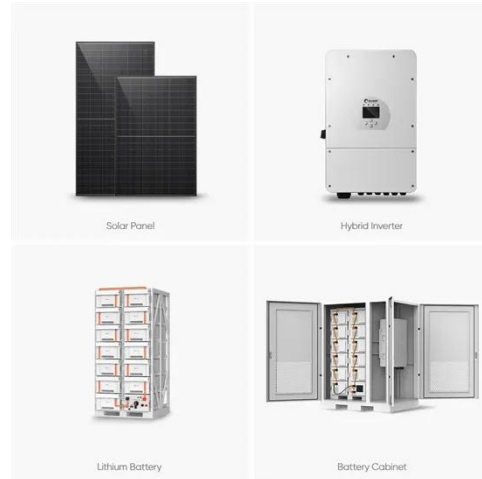
Can a House With Solar Panels Use a Generator?
